VOTING SYSTEM MANUAL AUDIT RESULTS

Members of the Canvassing Board and Elections' office staff met at 9:30a.m. on Monday, March 28, 2016 at the Supervisor of Elections office, to conduct a manual audit for the voting system used in the March 15, 2016 Presidential Preference Primary Election as required by Florida law. The precinct and race was randomly selected and the audit included Election Day, absentee, early voting and any provisional ballots.

The results of the audit show that the ballots manually tallied and compared with the count of the votes tabulated by the voting system to be the same and therefore, completely accurate.
