FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE. WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

Only voters who are registered members of a political party may vote for that party's candidates in a primary election, UNLESS the race is a Universal Primary Contest. A Universal Primary Contest occurs when all candidates in the same race have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election. All eligible voters can vote in a Universal Primary Contest.

The deadline for a voter to make a party affiliation change for the Primary Election is August 1, 2016.

All eligible voters regardless of party affiliation may vote on Nonpartisan offices (School Board Member) and on the Constitutional Amendment.
