

FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE WITH UNIVERSIAL PRIMARY CONTESTS

Closed Primary Contest

Only voters who are registered members of political party may vote for their respective party's candidates in a Primary Election.

Universal Primary Contest

If all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation, and the winner will have no opposition in the General Election, all qualified voters, regardless of party affiliation, may vote in the Primary Election for that office. This is known as a "Universal Primary Contest."

On the 2022 Primary Election ballot, there are three Universal Primary Contests, as well as nonpartisan races that are applicable to all registered voters, regardless of party affiliation. Those races are listed below:

- State Representative, District 5 -Universal Primary Contest
- County Commissioner, District 2- Universal Primary Contest
- County Commissioner, District 4- Universal Primary Contest
